Adults who are blind or visually impaired learn skills to lead fuller, more productive lives in **Wayfinder's Davidson Program for Independence**, a comprehensive residential rehabilitation program. Through training in Braille, independent living skills, assistive technology, and orientation and mobility (to travel autonomously and safely), graduates of the program reach their greatest levels of independence in their homes, workplaces and communities.

AT A GLANCE

- Comprehensive residential rehabilitation program located on Wayfinder's Los Angeles campus, with amenities including a gymnasium, fitness room, swimming pool, hot tub and bowling alley, as well as access to local public transportation
- Individualized orientation and mobility training, including instruction on white cane use, crossing streets safely and using public transportation independently
- Instruction in Braille reading and writing, and full access to a Braille library
- Assistive technology training in our state-of-the-art computer technology center
- Two fully equipped training apartments for real-world experience and skill development
- Adjustment counseling for individuals, groups and families
