SERVICES OFFERED

- Utilizes the Kevin Campbell Family Finding Model
- Create connections between relatives (including siblings) and child/youth
- Collaboration with county social worker and other service providers
- Case mine in CWS and child file
- Meet with birth parents
- Meet with all available relatives/NREFMs
- Meet with the child/youth
- Conduct extensive search for relatives utilizing paid and free search sites
- Field all phone calls related to letters sent to potential relatives/NREFMs
- Complete a family tree/genogram
- Provide support, education, and guidance to relatives throughout the process
- Help assess and connect youth to services to address identified needs
- Attend court hearings with relative/youth
- Assist with transitional plans for children who are being placed with a relative/NREFM
- Communicate with child welfare staff throughout the process
- Closure summary with all known relatives/NREFMs sent to CSW
