AT A GLANCE

- The goal of Home to Stay is family stabilization
- Families receive up to 12 weeks of in-home parent coaching and counseling services.
- Combining parent coaching and counseling allows family members to:
 - identify what triggers challenging behaviors
 - develop tools to manage crisis
 - integrate skills they have learned
 - identify and utilize a self-care plan
 - encourage the use of both informal and formal supports
 - ensure they are referred to the right provider when services end

What is Home to Stay?

Home to Stay provides short-term intensive parenting education and counseling to birth and kinship families whose children are at risk of out-of-home placement. Risk factors may be due to behavioral, emotional, or mental health issues of the children. It may also be due to the caregivers not having the skills to manage the children's behaviors or being at risk of not providing a safe home environment.
